

Do You Know a Young Person Facing a Criminal Charge in Manhattan or Queens? We May Be Able to Help

You can contact us if you know a child between the ages of 7 to 17:

- Who has been arrested or is wanted by the Police (or law enforcement), or
- Who has been summoned to the Criminal Court Youth Part, or
- Who has been summoned to meet with a Probation officer in Family Court

Center for Family Representation (CFR) supports families in Queens and Manhattan where there is a risk of family separation--For nearly two decades, CFR has been advocating for parents involved with the City's Administration for Children's Services (ACS) and the Family Courts. Nationally recognized for our work in keeping families together, our mission is to support parents in raising their children safely and prevent family separation. We work in teams of Attorneys, Social Work Staff and Parent Advocates—our Parent Advocates have personal experience losing children to foster care and then getting them back home.

We have expanded this team model to assist families where a young person may be at risk of incarceration because of an arrest or a prosecution in Manhattan or Queens.

We may also be able to provide team advocacy for your family with challenges you have with **housing and public benefits**, **immigration** or **accessing services**.
